This week we are invited by the Church to reflect on the ministry of angels. Tuesday is the feast of the archangels, Gabriel, Raphael, and Michael. Friday is the memorial of the Guardian Angels. The term angel means messenger. God created the angels to be his emissaries of peace and good news. These beloved are still active, especially during these turbulent times.

In Tobit 5, 1-8 we are told the story of Raphael:

Tobiah went out to look for someone who would travel with him to Media, someone who knew the way. He went out and found the angel Raphael standing before him (though he did not know that this was an angel of God).

5Tobiah said to him, "Where do you come from, young man?" He replied, "I am an Israelite, one of your kindred. I have come here to work." Tobiah said to him, "Do you know the way to Media?"

6"Yes," he replied, "I have been there many times. I know the place well and am acquainted with all the routes. I have often traveled to Media; I used to stay with our kinsman Gabael, who lives at Rages in Media. It is a good two days' journey from Ecbatana to Rages, for Rages is situated in the mountains, but Ecbatana is in the middle of the plain."

7Tobiah said to him, "Wait for me, young man, till I go in and tell my father; for I need you to make the journey with me. I will pay you your wages."

8He replied, "Very well, I will wait; but do not be long."

Here we read that Raphael guided Tobias as do the angels guide our journey through life through the cross to resurrection. Pray to the angels, to direct our ways, and to bring us God's consolation.





## Back To School Drive Update



During these unprecedented times everything is different for us all. The Back to School Drive is no exception. The Ministry For Those in Need has been working with the St. Vincent DePaul Society of the Diocese of Cleveland for many years to provide school supplies to schools and children in need. As you may expect the need is different this year. Due to many schools not being open at this time there has

not been the usual requests. The minimal requests that have been made are for supplies to be purchased in bulk directly by SVDP and delivered directly to the school. While these needs are already met and there are not any current requests SVDP does expect future requests.

The Ministry continues to be committed to this project even during these strange times. Thus we are currently doing the following:

- As in the past we are helping our local community. The Ministry has already assisted in purchasing supplies for school children of families that we assist in our community. We also have assisted our neighbors at Ledgeview School in purchasing needed supplies. We have already committed \$400 to those areas this year.
- The Ministry has informed SVDP that we will commit funds to assisting with a future request from a school. This may not occur for several months as schools hopefully begin to reopen and have a need for supplies or other assistance.

So how can the Parishioners of OLG be of assistance? While we cannot accept actual school supplies this year, in the past a full set of supplies was valued at \$17. If you would like to make a monetary donation to pay for the equivalent of one or more sets please designate it on an envelope and drop it in the collection basket at church. These funds will be placed in a designated school supplies fund for use when requests do come for supplies from the local community or SVDP during the school year.

It is through the amazing generosity and support from the parishioners of OLG that allows the Ministry to make an impact not just in our community but also in surrounding communities.
