We heard in today's gospel:

*The Lord said to her in reply,  
"Martha, Martha, you are anxious and worried about many things.  
There is a need for only one thing.  
Mary has chosen the better part  
and it will not be taken from her."*

Too many have interpreted the gospel to place prayer over action! Jesus is not placing prayerful listening over action. He is inviting us to remember Him first in our lives and follow him in prayer and action. It is a mistake to proclaim a person who prays intensely over a mother caring for four children! Prayer and action show our love for the One who is the better part! Both are entering into the heart of Jesus.

**WORDS OF THE HOLY FATHER FRANCIS**

In this scene of Mary of Bethany at Jesus' feet, the gospel writer shows the prayerful attitude of Mary, who is in the Teacher's presence to listen and be in union with him. It means that we, too, should pause in prayer several times a day, to gather in silence at the feet of the Master, to make room for the Lord. This reminds us to find the courage to stay with him, find peace and strength to guide everyday matters, and act as Martha beautifully demonstrates. Commending the conduct of Mary, who "has chosen the good portion" (v. 42), Jesus seems to repeat to each of us: "Do not allow yourselves to be overwhelmed by things to do, but first and foremost listen to the Lord's voice, to properly carry out the tasks that life assigns to you." (Pope Francis, Angelus, 21 July 2019)

Sunday Eucharist is our weekly meeting at the table of the Lord to be fed by Him in Word and Sacrament. In the Eucharist, we are given passion for continuing through life. Thank you for your faithfulness to Sunday Eucharist.

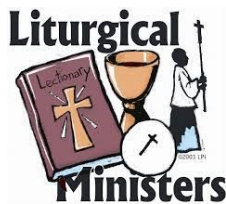
