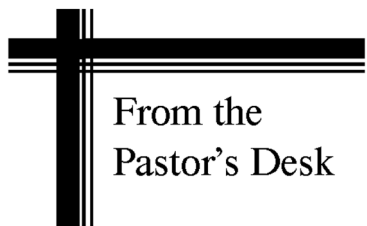

Dear Friends,

Isaiah was a prophet of our Tradition who spoke for the Lord calling us to hear the words of the Lord. His words are mercy and justice. He called us to peace. Isaiah connects works of mercy, feeding the hungry and clothing and sheltering the poor, as breaking the darkness of our day. Each time we give of our time, our finances for the poor and the works of the Church, and our time we light our world with God! God answers and is present in our midst.

The gospel presents further images of salt and light that tells us of our call. Salt breaks the ice of our roads and sidewalks, savors our food. Light brings direction, confidence and courage in the dark. We as disciples of Jesus are carriers of the light of our Baptism and salt of the earth.

If any who are adults, 18 and over, have not fully initiated baptism, confirmation and First Eucharist, please call or see me. We can celebrate the sacraments at the Easter Vigil. Do not hesitate to present yourself to Christ through the Church to experience these saving acts of God and His acceptance into our faith and parish of Our Lady of Guadalupe.

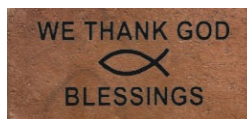
**CCA Grief Support February 19th "In-Office" at 3:00pm

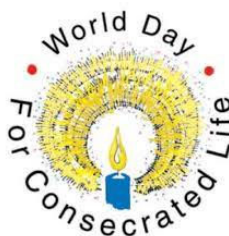
