## THEOLOGY ON TAP

*"Creation as Gift"*

A Reflection on JP II's Meditation on Givenness

with Gregg and Dr. Elizabeth Stovicek

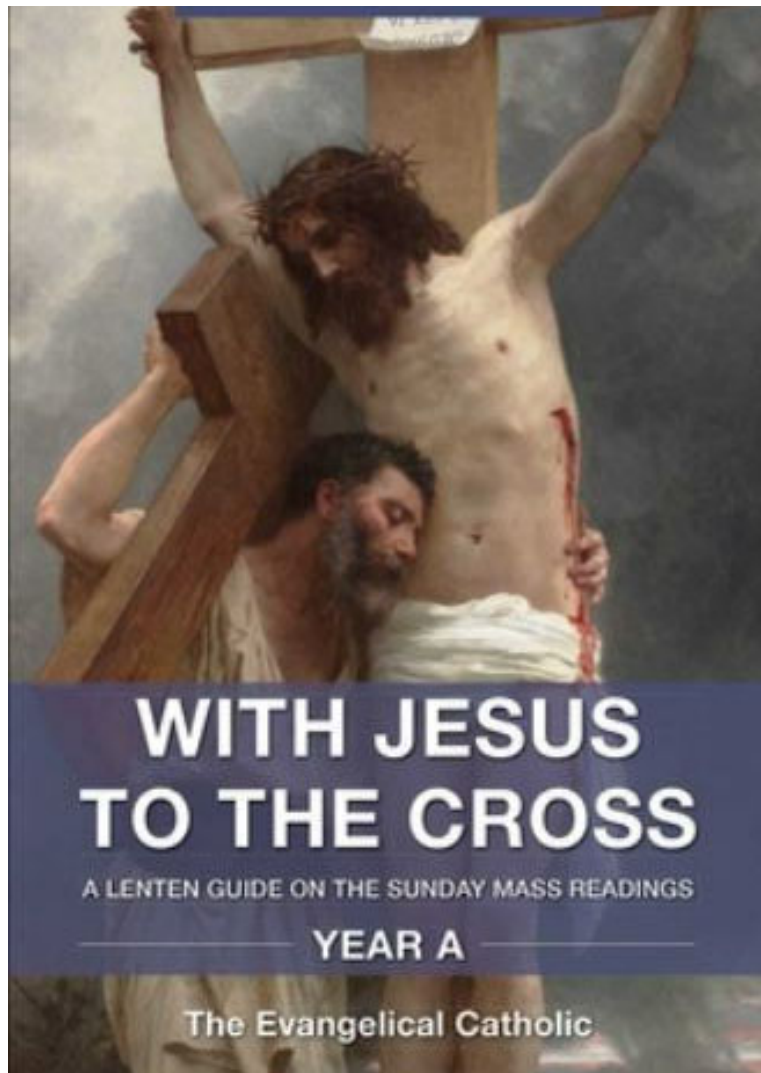
