The bags will be available after masses the weekend of March 4th & 5th.

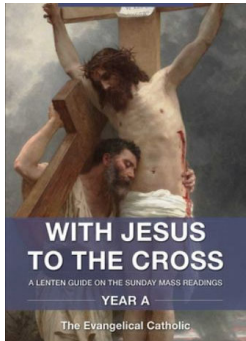
How it will work:

Any adults beyond high school who have not been confirmed are invited to become involved in the process that will lead to the Sacrament of Confirmation. Being fully initiated in the Church (that is, have received Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation) is a necessary prerequisite in serving as Baptismal Godparent or Confirmation sponsor.
