## Welcome to Lent!

Every year we are called to a renewal of mind, heart and spirit. We call this renewal, **Lent**, a time to put on in a more concentrated way the "**good works**" of prayer, fasting and alms-giving. These three "**pillars**" of Lent draw us into a deeper understanding of who we are; that is, a baptized and faithful follower of the Lord. They urge us to repent and return, to reconcile and renew ourselves once again in the spirit of Christ!

*These are the "pillars" that guide us in the Holy Season of Lent:*

### *Fasting*

**Ash Wednesday** and **Good Friday**: How do we fast? When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal.

**Abstinence** is for those 14 years and older from meat on Fridays.

### *Giving alms*

Two primary ways here at our parish. **Blessing Bags** are our parish Lenten Project: Blessing Bags are goods collected and distributed to the Peter Maurin, VA Hospital and Battered Women Shelter. Contributions are made to Ministry for Those in Need along with the

**Catholic Charities Appeal.**

## The Liturgy of The Word

### \*1<sup>st</sup> Reading: \_\_\_\_\_ Genesis 2:7-9; 3:1-7

The LORD God formed man out of the clay of the ground and blew into his nostrils the breath of life, and so man became a living being. Then the LORD God planted a garden in Eden, in the east, and placed there the man whom he had formed. Out

of the ground the LORD God made various trees grow that were delightful to look at and good for food, with the tree of life in the middle of the garden and the tree of the knowledge of good and evil. Now the serpent was the most cunning of all the animals that the LORD God had made. The serpent asked the woman, “Did God really tell you not to eat from any of the trees in the garden?” The woman answered the serpent: “We may eat of the fruit of the trees in the garden; it is only about the fruit of the tree in the middle of the garden that God said, ‘You shall not eat it or even touch it, lest you die.’” But the serpent said to the woman: “You certainly will not die! Then the eyes of both of them were opened, and they realized that they were naked; so they sewed fig leaves together and made loincloths for themselves.

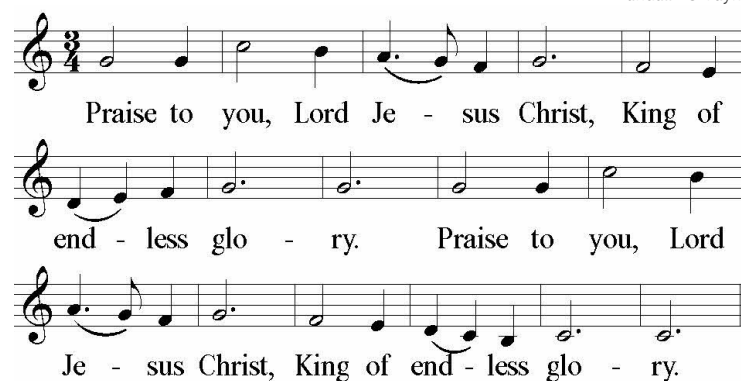
**\*2<sup>nd</sup> Reading:** \_\_\_\_\_ Romans 5: 11-19 or 5: 12, 17-19

Brothers and sisters: Through one man sin entered the world, and through sin, death, and thus death came to all men, inasmuch as all sinned—for up to the time of the law, sin was in the world, though sin is not accounted when there is no law. But death reigned from Adam to Moses, even over those who did not sin after the pattern of the trespass of Adam, who is the type of the one who was to come. But the gift is not like the transgression. For if by the transgression of the one, the many died, how much more did the grace of God and the gracious gift of the one man Jesus Christ overflow for the many. And the gift

is not like the result of the one who sinned. For after one sin there was the judgment that brought condemnation; but the gift, after many transgressions, brought acquittal. 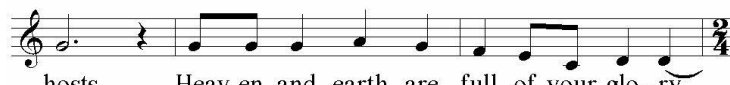

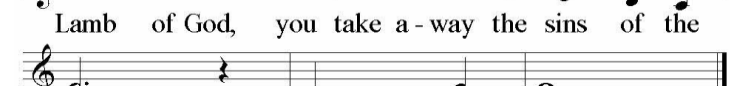

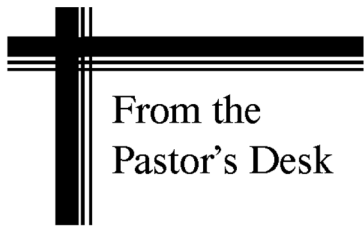
