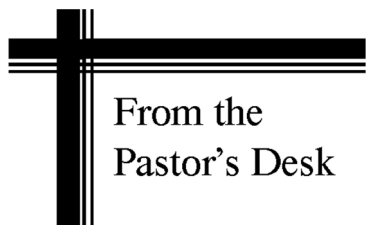

This conversation between Jesus and the Samaritan woman is one that we can identify. How many times do we feel parched in our own lives and desire to be quenched by the life giving water of Jesus? How many times do we come back to the well to look for Jesus? If you are like me, the answer to that is multiple times each day.

As I was reading a book on evangelization, "Start with Jesus", the author Julianne Stanz, says this: "What do you see when you look into a well? If you peer down into the inky blackness, all you see is darkness. But if you are at the bottom of the well, what do you see? Light."

I love this image: Jesus meets the woman at a place where light and darkness meet. Sometimes, we get caught looking down into our own darkness. We need reminded to look up into the light to keep our eyes fixed on Jesus. With that comes hope of eternal life of Christ. We will never thirst again!

Next weekend (March 17-19), Our Lady of Guadalupe is privileged to host an event where Christ's Passion is portrayed on stage, the long running musical of Tetelestai. Tetelestai is Greek for "It is Finished," the last words Jesus spoke from the cross. I would like to personally invite all of you to come and witness the last days of Jesus' life, in the hope of enhancing your Lenten journey. I, along with my family, have been involved in this ministry for many years and I am very excited that OLG has opened their doors for this ministry. If you do plan to come, I ask you to bring a friend or family member so they too, look to the light to see the love and hope in Jesus.

Performances are March 17- 8pm, March 18- 8pm, and March 19- 2pm. We do not sell tickets, as it is free admission. Donations will be accepted. I hope to see all of you at the performance.

If you would like to contribute to this event- I'd ask you to bake or donate cookies for our reception. You can drop them at the church anytime this week.

May your Lenten journey lead you closer to Jesus as you continue looking up toward the light.


## The Liturgy of The Word



You people worship what you do not understand; we worship what we understand, because salvation is from the Jews. But the hour is coming, and is now here, when true worshipers will worship the Father in Spirit and truth; and indeed the Father seeks such people to worship him. God is Spirit, and those who worship him must worship in Spirit and truth.” The woman said to him, “I know that the Messiah is coming, the one called the Christ; when he comes, he will tell us everything.” Jesus said to her, “I am he, the one who is speaking with you.” Many of the Samaritans of that town began to believe in him. When the Samaritans came to him, they invited him to stay with them; and he stayed there two days. Many more began to believe in him because of his word, and they said to the woman, “We no longer believe because of your word; for we have heard for ourselves, and we know that this is truly the savior of the world.”
