Dear Friends,

Today in the gospel we hear one of the greatest proclamations of faith. Martha says to her friend and Lord Jesus:

"Yes. Lord.

I have come to believe that you are Christ, the Son of God, the one who is coming into the world." (John 11)

As the Christ, Jesus has power over death in all its forms. When God created the world, God did not create death. God desires that we live forever. Death is an enemy, Sin results in death. God loves us forever. God in Jesus' passion, death and resurrection abolished our death.

But we fear death. Death is against our nature. Martha declared the faith of the Church in Jesus Christ. The fall of humanity into death is saved through Jesus and our faith in Him. In Jesus God wept when sin and death entered our world. At the grave of Lazarus, Jesus wept the tears of God: tears of grief connected with hope in the resurrection. Both are necessary.

Death is not God's plan for us. We cry, God cries in his Son giving hope. Jesus is Christ and our entry into a new world without death.

Next weekend, we begin Solemn Holy Week with Palms on the Sunday of the Lord's Passion culminating with the Three days of Easter from Holy Thursday evening ending on Easter Sunday. We welcome Bishop Roger Gries to our Parish of Our Lady of Guadalupe. Bishop Roger will preside at the most Solemn Mass at 10:30 am on Sunday morning with a Procession and proclamation of Matthew's Passion narrative.

Mr. Matthew and the Tetelestai community gave a most beautiful presentation last weekend for our Parish and the city of Macedonia. I invite you to read his words:
