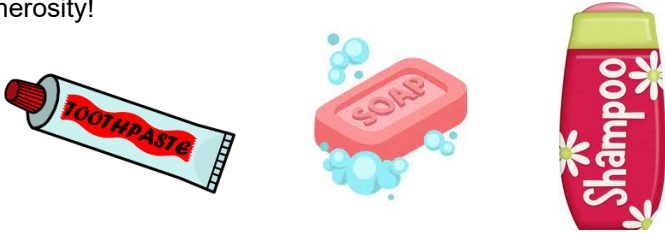
The Peter Maurin Center is an outreach ministry that works directly with the homeless in Akron. They are asking for donations of the following items in small or personal sizes: Body
