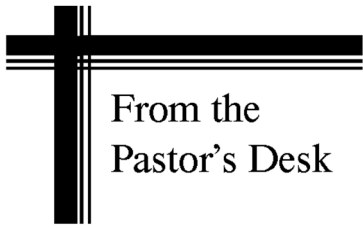

Dear Friends,

Jesus invites us to faith as he takes us to the Last Supper table. The beauty of the Liturgy is we are at the table again with him and we know our destiny: the cross, death and resurrection. *Jesus invites us not to worry.* We are to place our trust and deep relationship in the Father and Him. Our faith begins with the Father calling us sons and daughters through Jesus the son of God. We are one family in the Spirit.

Docile to the Father as our Creator and destiny we come to know Jesus as our way of truth and life. Faith is a movement of the Holy Spirit in our hearts sent from the heart of the crucified Jesus.

All our life is initiated by the Father who calls us by name at Baptism, guiding us in Jesus and moving us through the Spirit. When we make the sign of the cross our first prayer we affirm the Father, follow the Son and live in the Holy Spirit. Say the prayer every morning, and before we sleep at night. We begin the Sunday Eucharist with this sign and are sent with the blessing of the Trinity

This afternoon our young people are **Confirmed in the Spirit**. Bishop Martin Amos will preside at the Eucharist and anoint them with oil of chrism, calling the Spirit to enliven them with the seven gifts.

If you or anyone you know has not yet celebrated the sacrament of Confirmation, please invite them to let me know or Deacon Dave or Mr. Matthew. Confirmation is essential to following the Lord Jesus into the Father's heart.

I thank Mr. Matthew Griffith, the confirmation team, sponsors, and families for their ministry to our young people.

God bless those called and chosen by the Father to receive the Spirit and now to take their place with us as we fulfill the mission of the Church.

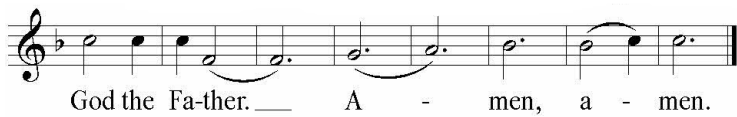

The Liturgy of The Word

* 1st Reading: Acts 6: 1-7

As the number of disciples continued to grow, the Hellenists complained against the Hebrews because their widows were being neglected in the daily distribution. So the Twelve called together the community of the disciples and said, "It is not right for us to neglect the word of God to serve at table. Brothers, select from among you seven reputable men, filled with the Spirit and wisdom, whom we shall appoint to this task, whereas we shall devote ourselves to prayer and to the ministry of the word." The proposal was acceptable to the whole community, so they chose Stephen, a man filled with faith and the Holy Spirit, also Philip, Prochorus, Nicanor, Timon, Parmenas, and Nicholas of Antioch, a convert to Judaism. They presented these men to the apostles who prayed and laid hands on them. The word of God continued to spread, and the number of the disciples in Jerusalem increased greatly; even a large group of priests were becoming obedient to the faith.

We'll see Cleveland's University Circle and the well known **Little Italy**, but also visit the original area of **Big Italy**, and it's most famous inhabitant whose product became a worldwide success and is probably in your kitchen today.
