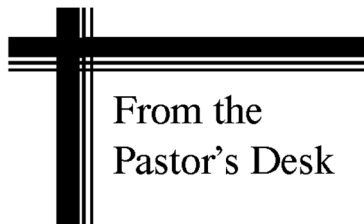

Dear Friends,

Jesus says to us in the gospel:

*I am with you always, until the end of the age."*

Some of us feel abandoned or ask, "Where did he go?" but many of us tend toward Jesus Christ as having left us for the distant land of heaven as he ascends to the Father! We observed images of him climbing the clouds, like steps to the gates of heaven and the throne of God.

I would like you to take another perspective. Jesus, on this day, instead lifts us in this life over darkness and sin. He gives hope in the life to come. We are still connected with Him and to the Father. Sure, this mystery is difficult to understand. We would rather see and touch the risen Christ. In the future, we will experience Christ and each other differently. Although life is similar, there is a fuller life of love and intimacy.

The Ascension of Jesus is another aspect of his passing into the heart of the Father.

Our connection to Christ remains through prayer and worship at the Eucharist. Daily prayer, as making the sign of the cross, makes us aware of his personal choice to stay with us. We meet the risen and ascended Christ in the sacrament of Baptism, in which water is poured from his side on the cross-causing union with the Father, Son, and Spirit. Jesus teaches us to show Him in our love and compassion for others.

Lastly, Jesus abides in us, and we are assured of his power. We often feel powerless over the darkness of life because we choose to stand alone. We cannot stand alone! When we gather, the power of Christ can raise us over sin and death into the heart of the Father.

Tuesday, May 23, is our Diocesan celebration of the Eucharist for our Priest Jubilarians. The Mass is at 11 am at St. Basil Church in Brecksville. There will not be a noon Mass here on Tuesday since I am one of the Jubilarians and my fortieth anniversary of priesthood.

Next Saturday, beginning at 4.15 pm, we will celebrate an extended Vigil on the solemnity of Pentecost. The evening will begin with Vespers, then the celebration of the Eucharist, which will take on a little different character. Please join us as we call on the Holy Spirit to enter our hearts and our world.

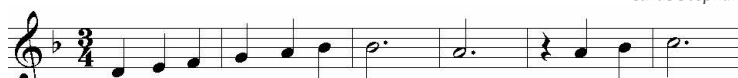

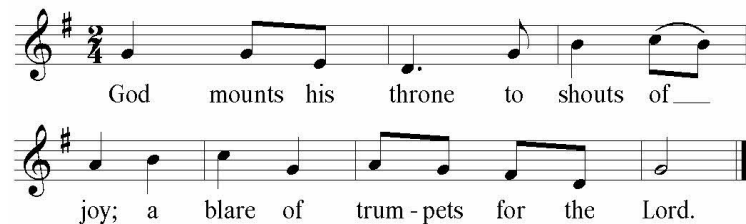
# The Liturgy of The Word

## \* 1<sup>st</sup> Reading: Acts 1: 1-11

In the first book, Theophilus, I dealt with all that Jesus did and taught until the day he was taken up, after giving instructions through the Holy Spirit to the apostles whom he had chosen. He presented himself alive to them by many proofs after he had suffered, appearing to them during forty days and speaking about the kingdom of God. While meeting with them, he enjoined them not to depart from Jerusalem, but to wait for “the promise of the Father about which you have heard me speak; for John baptized with water, but in a few days you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit.” When they had gathered together they asked him, “Lord, are you at this time going to restore the kingdom to Israel?” He answered them, “It is not for you to know the times or seasons that the Father has established by his own authority. But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, throughout Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.” When he had said this, as they were looking on, he was lifted up, and a cloud took him from their sight. While they were looking intently at the sky as he was going, suddenly two men dressed in white garments stood beside them. They said, “Men of Galilee, why are you standing there looking at the sky? This Jesus who has been taken up from you into heaven will return in the same way as you have seen him going into heaven.”

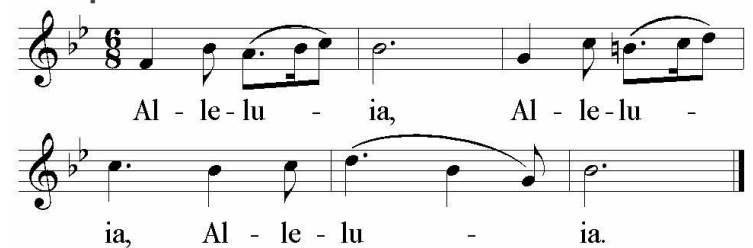



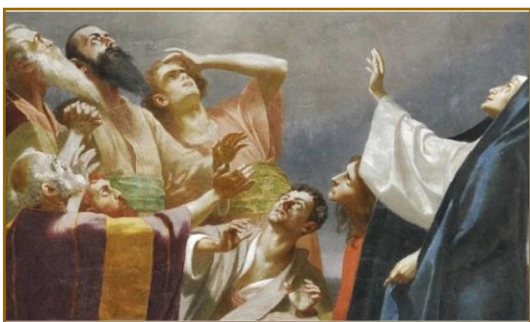
