### **The Peter Maurin Center Donation Bin**

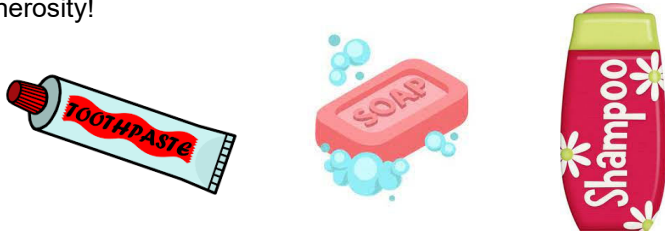

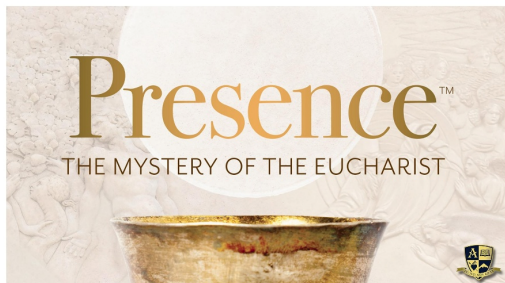
