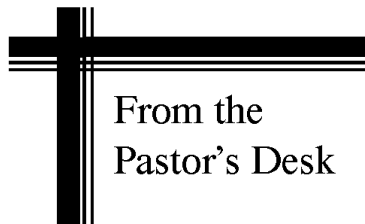

Dear Friends,

Most of us are guilty of quick judgment. Jesus, in the Sunday gospel parable of the weeds and wheat, confronts our sin. The Church is filled both with goodness and evil! This truth may surprise us. We expect all holy members! Each of us is a sinner and, at the same time, holy. There is no room for judgment. We are especially hard on our leaders, who we always claim to be holy and available.

The parable teaches us that God permits weeds to grow in the garden. Early Church leaders interpreted this to mean they were left amid the Church because there was a possibility of repentance right to the end. This is true. But in reality, weeds don't become wheat!

Why does God permit evil ones to remain?

Sin should move us to mercy! Evil is overcome with mercy! The Church is mercy. Instead of quick judgments, let us show mercy to the sinner and reveal the God of Love! I invite you to show mercy to the sinner and yourself!

Tomorrow evening Monday, I will celebrate the sacrament of Confession, the mercy of Christ, in the adoration chapel from 5.30 -7 pm. Evening Prayer, Vespers are prayed at 6.15 pm. Please join me in the blessed Sacrament of Penance.

The summer is a time of prayer and love. Please keep the Sabbath holy by celebrating the Eucharist and acts of love and mercy throughout the week.

Flight 93 National Memorial

With the OLG Young at Heart Seniors

Wednesday, August 16, 2023

Every US Citizen that has lived through the events of 9/11, were witnesses to a devastating attack on our nation. The importance of 9/11 transcends age, gender and even political differences. Now, over 20 years later we are able to reflect on this event in person as we take in the inspirational and emotional site of the Flight 93 National Memorial in central Pennsylvania.

JKL Tours is proud to offer this experience and in order to provide you as much time as possible at this site, we will be heading directly there. As you read the itinerary below, you'll see the information we can provide to help you make the most of your time, but we encourage you to research it on your own. During our time there, we'll see the 3 main areas and take in a daily presentation by a National Park Ranger.

7:30 AM: Motorcoach available to board
7:45 AM: Depart promptly from OLG

We will make plaza stops enroute including a **LUNCH on your own** stop along the Pennsylvania Turnpike in Somerset, PA. There is a food court with the options of Burger King, Starbucks (with sandwiches), Popeye's Chicken, Auntie Ann's Pretzel, etc.

- ♦ **12:00 pm:** Approximate arrival at Flight 93 National Memorial. We will have a handout on the bus explaining the tremendous story of the courage of these brave patriots willing to pay the ultimate sacrifice. Free time on your own to explore the upper area and Visitors Center which has many exhibits detailing the events leading up to that day, along with how the events of that day happened. There is also an easily walkable lookout providing an overview of the area. You can walk the trail to the lower area, where the Memorial Plaza is located. It is 3,000 feet on a gentle incline.
- ♦ **1:15 pm:** There is an optional bus transfer to the lower area where the Memorial Plaza is located. The Memorial Plaza offers a walking path so you can see the remaining boulder where the plane crashed down, along with the Memorial Wall listing the names of the patriots.
- ♦ **1:30 pm:** A National Park Ranger will provide an overview talk of about 30 minutes. Meet by the flag pole and there are benches there to hear the talk.
- ♦ **2:45 pm:** Depart from the lower level and stop at the Tower of Voices monument which is a giant windchime that is a unique monument.
- ♦ **3:15 pm:** Depart for home. Plaza stops enroute to be determined.
- ♦ **7:00 pm:** Approximate arrival at OLG parking lot.
