With the OLG Young at Heart Seniors Wednesday, August 16, 2023

Every US Citizen that has lived through the events of 9/11, were witnesses to a devastating attack on our nation. The importance of 9/11 transcends age, gender and even political differences. Now, over 20 years later we are able to reflect on this event in person as we take in the inspirational and emotional site of the Flight 93 National Memorial in central Pennsylvania.

- ◆ 12:00 pm: Approximate arrival at Flight 93 National Memorial.
