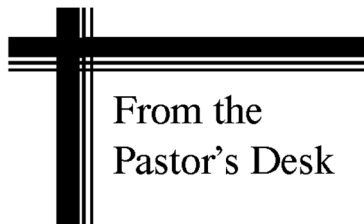

Dear Friends,

God is timeless. On the mountain when Jesus took Peter, James and John into the cloud of the mystery of the cross, Jesus permitted them to encounter the yet to come in time, resurrection. Jesus knew they needed this beautiful moment of hope to face the cross. Peter blurted out! **It is good for us to be here!** Well of course! The moment was good and holy, timeless, filled with pleasure, peace, and salvation. They did not want to leave. Neither did Jesus!

But they had to leave the mountain. They would go to the cross with Jesus. There they would face death and preach the resurrection.

Don't we need hope too? We are facing the cross as we pass in time to God. We need moments of the timelessness of Christ, called transfiguration.

Father Erasmo Leiva-Merikakis writes:

Transfiguration is the experience of fullness and glory now, in our very midst, in this world of change and disappointment. (2003 San Francisco: **Ignatius Press**, , p. 551)

The Eucharist on Sunday is our first moment of Transfiguration. These should be moments of rest, peace and hope with Christ and one another. As we stand at his table, may we enter the mystery of the cross to make sense of life and encounter the glory of God to come.

Next Tuesday is the Assumption of Mary, August 15. This is a holyday of obligation, meaning we are to participate in the Mass, Mass is celebrated at Guadalupe at noon and 6.30 pm on the day.

Let's continue to enjoy our summer and enter the Fall refreshed and ready to deepen faith by our regular participation at Church, work, and taking care of family.

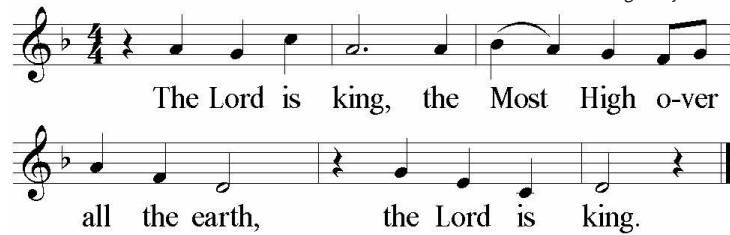
*1st Reading _____ Daniel 7: 9-10, 13-14

7:30 AM: Motorcoach available to board

7:45 AM: Depart promptly from OLG

We will make plaza stops enroute including a **LUNCH on your own** stop along the Pennsylvania Turnpike in Somerset, PA. There is a food court with the options of Burger King, Starbucks (with sandwiches), Popeye's Chicken, Auntie Ann's Pretzel, etc.

- ◆ **12:00 pm:** Approximate arrival at Flight 93 National Memorial. We will have a handout on the bus explaining the tremendous story of the courage of these brave patriots willing to pay the ultimate sacrifice. Free time on your own to explore the upper area and Visitors Center which has many exhibits detailing the events leading up to that day, along with how the events of that day happened. There is also an easily walkable lookout providing an overview of the area. You can walk the trail to the lower area, where the Memorial Plaza is located. It is 3,000 feet on a gentle incline.
- ◆ **1:15 pm:** There is an optional bus transfer to the lower area where the Memorial Plaza is located. The Memorial Plaza offers a walking path so you can see the remaining boulder where the plane cashed down, along with the Memorial Wall listing the names of the patriots.
- ◆ **1:30 pm:** A National Park Ranger will provide an overview talk of about 30 minutes. Meet by the flag pole and there are benches there to hear the talk.
- ◆ **2:45 pm:** Depart from the lower level and stop at the Tower of Voices monument which is a giant windchime that is a unique monument.
- ◆ **3:15 pm:** Depart for home. Plaza stops enroute to be determined.
- ◆ **7:00 pm:** Approximate arrival at OLG parking lot.
