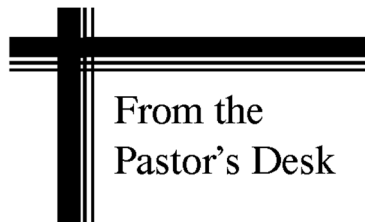

Dear Friends,



Last Sunday, I wrote that God is timeless, as we heard the gospel, the disciples' encounter with God in Jesus' Transfiguration. We have experienced timelessness uniquely on Sunday at Mass. Little Hannah listened and responded by drawing the picture I included in this article! Thank you, Hannah, for illustrating your faith for us. I found her picture inspiring as she connected the Eucharist to her and our life!

The gospel today reveals Jesus' power in our lives:

*But when he saw how strong the wind was, Peter became frightened; and, beginning to sink, he cried, "Lord, save me!" Immediately, Jesus stretched out his hand, caught Peter, and said to him, "O you of little faith, why did you doubt?" After they got into the boat, the wind died down. Those who were in the boat did him homage, saying, "Truly, you are the Son of God." (Mt. 14, 22-33)*

Today's illustration could be the mighty hand of Jesus catching hold of us! There is nothing to fear. Jesus invites us only to ask and take his hand and heart. Amid trials and tribulations, the Lord Jesus Christ saves us. He calms us through his quiet presence. May we deepen our faith in Him to bring us safely home.

Tuesday is the solemnity of the Assumption of Mary. In this great feast, Mary is taken body and soul into the heart of her Son. We celebrate this great festival at Mass. **Mass is at noon and 6.30 pm on Tuesday. This is holyday of obligation.**

**O, God**, you have taken to yourself the blessed Virgin Mary, mother of your incarnate Son: Grant that we, who his blood has redeemed, may share with her the glory of your eternal kingdom; through Jesus Christ our Lord, who lives and reigns with you, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God, now and forever. Amen.
