

# From the Desk of Deacon Dave



Our Lady of Guadalupe Church fiscal year ended June 30, 2023. The expenses exceeded our income by a little over \$80,000. At the end of May and into early June, we had the parking lot repaved and striped in the main parking area, and the entrance/exit lanes resealed.

The paving and resealing cost the parish \$108,000. The good news is we have a functional parking lot that should be good for at least the next 20 years. More good news is that we could pay cash for it because we had funds available from our Repair, Replace, and Rejuvenate (RRR) funds. The bad news, we must replace that \$108,000 in our savings funds to ensure we have funds available for future capital projects. \$108,000 may seem like a large sum if we break that down by week over the next year; an additional \$2,000 per week would result in \$6,000-\$7,000 per month to replenish the fund.

We can't neglect our ordinary monthly reoccurring expenses, such as payroll for staff, health insurance, pension expense, and daily operating expenses. As with your expenses and budgets at home, you can't just focus on major repairs and not be concerned about ordinary household expenses.

We invite you to pray and discern how much to give to the parish of Our Lady of Guadalupe and adjust your giving level. We appreciate your witness of being faithful to financial giving to the Church. Suppose you haven't discerned recently about taking your role seriously as an active supporter of the Church of Our Lady of Guadalupe. In that case, I invite you to take a leap of faith, spend some quiet time with the Lord, and see if he might call you to our parish's active financial support.

We need your active financial support and participation regardless of age or life situation. You might be raising a family with younger children or a family that is experiencing high school and/or college with our children. We may be empty nesters or senior citizens. Regardless of where we are in the spectrum of life, we can't ignore the responsibility we have to care for our parish financially.

In our Gospel this weekend, Jesus asks Peter, "Who do people say I am?" After Peter responds, Jesus asks Peter, "But who do you say I am?" We hear Peter's act of faith in Jesus.

We, too, must ask ourselves, "But do I say Jesus is?" and then listen and act accordingly.




