### Adult Altar Servers, Ushers, Greeters, Music Ministry, Lectors, and Eucharistic Ministers

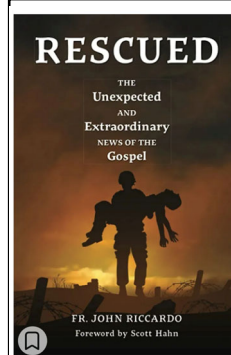
