Two weeks ago on Tuesday, October 24, we had the privilege of having Auxiliary Bishop Michael Woost here at Our Lady of Guadalupe. This was his first visit to our parish since he was ordained Auxiliary Bishop on August 2, 2022. The Worship Commission invited him to address the members of our Altar Ministries: Lectors, Ushers and Greeters, Music Ministers, Adult Altar Servers, and Eucharistic Ministers. Altar Ministers from Ss. Cosmas and Damian in Twinsburg and The Church of The Resurrection in Solon were also invited; we had around 150 in attendance; about 50 were from our parish.

Bishop Woost gave an excellent talk with regards to our own ministries: its more than just reading out loud from the Lectionary, its more than just passing a basket, its more than just singing a melody, and its more than giving out Communion to assist the Celebrant at Mass. How we approach and prepare is vital to the way we minister. Through our ministry, God communicates to his people in many ways; we should all accept this responsibility with honor, dignity, and respect. God wants us to be in a relationship with him and in a relationship with each other and he makes himself known in ways that respect our capacity to receive him.

We are always looking for more people to become involved in any of our Altar Ministries. I know that one of the common statements people say to me when I invite them to any aspect of Altar Ministry is "Oh no, I can't do that; I don't think I am worthy enough." My reply to them is "You would be surprised to see how worthy you are! God knows we aren't perfect, even the disciples and saints weren't perfect."






## The Liturgy of The Word






