

We are coming to the end of Matthew's gospel with another story of courage and perseverance!

Sunday Mt 25:14-15, 19-21

Jesus told his disciples this parable:

"A man going on a journey

called in his servants and entrusted his possessions to them. To one, he gave five talents; to another, two; to a third, one-to each according to his ability.

Then he went away.

"After a long time

the master of those servants came back and settled accounts with them.

The one who had received five talents came forward bringing the additional five.

He said, 'Master, you gave me five talents.

See, I have made five more.'

His master said, 'Well done, my good and faithful servant.

Since you were faithful in small matters,

I will give you great responsibilities.

Come, share your master's joy."
