We are coming to the end of Matthew's gospel with another story of courage and perseverance!

Sunday Mt 25:14-15, 19-21

Jesus told his disciples this parable:

"A man going on a journey called in his servants and entrusted his possessions to them. To one, he gave five talents; to another, two; to a third, one--to each according to his ability. Then he went away.

"After a long time the master of those servants came back and settled accounts with them. The one who had received five talents came forward bringing the additional five. He said, 'Master, you gave me five talents. See, I have made five more.' His master said, 'Well done, my good and faithful servant. Since you were faithful in small matters, I will give you great responsibilities. Come, share your master's joy.'"

Many of our difficulties arise because of a poor self-image. This affects our confidence and the ability to do good. We are made in God's image and likeness and redeemed through Jesus' death and resurrection. This makes us a gift of God. We are called to confidence in God. This can move us to take holy risks in the Spirit.

The worker was confident. He traded his talents and money and made more! He knew his master would understand if he lost them. He had to take a chance if he were to move forward and find success.

No matter our age, skills, possessions, and status, we need to move forward every day that is given to us. God loves us and created our desires to serve him and find success and holiness. Today, look forward to God, who created and redeemed us in his Son, Jesus. We don't have to fear if we fail.

In baseball, a great hitter fails seven out of ten times! But the hits do come if we keep going to bat. Perseverance is also a key to courage and greatness.
