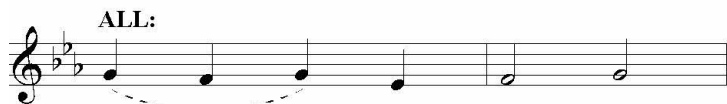

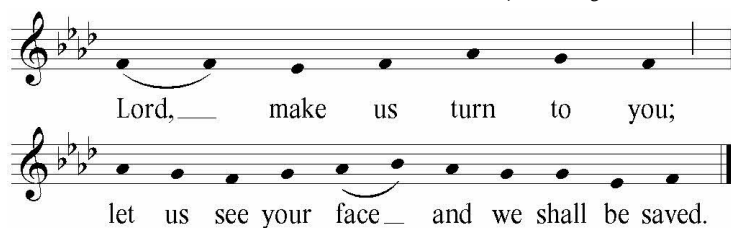
# The Liturgy of The Word
