On average, every week, over 60 volunteers supported this cause. The limited space here doesn't allow me to tip my hat and thank each and every one of them individually, but I can list so many of the things they did to make this success possible.

- » The weekly coordination of the available days and hours for all of the workers who volunteered their time begins each Monday.
- » The dining room set up begins on Thursday with tables, chairs, amenities and delicious desert carts filled with specialties from our dedicated bakers.
- » The kitchen work begins Thursday with inventory, shopping and purchasing, preparing and managing the kitchen hardware to be ready for Friday.
- » In the kitchen Friday begins with prepping and cooking, then plating meals to order, timing order traffic and running hot meals into the dining room.
- » Dining room support on Friday...hosting and seating diners, taking orders, serving meals and attending our customer's needs. The cashiers, phone orders, cart runners, ticket runners, take out order preppers...all followed by the massive kitchen cleanup after the last meal is served and the huge dining area cleanup that begins after the last guest has left.

Without all of these hardworking volunteers there could never be an OLG fish fry and I cannot express enough my appreciation and for their selfless involvement and hard work!

Indeed, I am deeply proud and truly blessed to be a part of this OLG parish community.

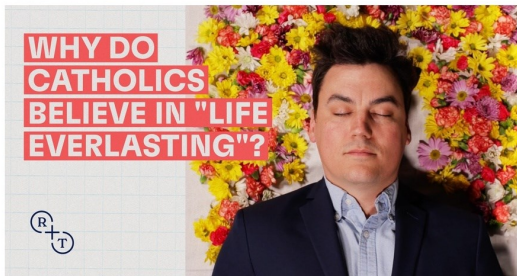

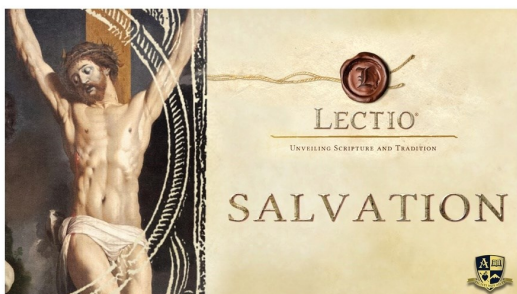
The Rosary: A Special Way to Pray
