Other things that you may wish to include in your wedding program are:

- 1 Where will you be having your receiving line?
 - If in church at the pew, ask them to remain in their pew following the ceremony, and you'll receive them there.
 - If at the reception, let them know not to expect one at the church.
- 2 A thank you to those who joined you in prayer at your wedding.
- 3 Your new address, phone number, cell numbers, e-mail address, *Facebook* page, etc.

BEFORE SENDING YOUR WEDDING PROGRAM TO THE PRINTER make sure the clergyman who will be presiding at your wedding has reviewed a proof copy!!

The Order of Worship

Ceremony participants may be listed, though it's not essential. If you choose to list them, they should only be in the vaguest of categories: Parents, Bridesmaids, Groomsmen, Musicians, etc. It is inappropriate to categorize each participant ... eg, friend of bride, etc.

Parents:

Mr. and Mrs. Parents of Bride
Mr. and Mrs. Parents of Groom

Bridesmaids:

List in order of procession
Include any flower girls in this listing (not separately)
Maid/Matron of honor should be the last person listed

Groomsmen:

List in order of procession
Include any ring bearers in this listing (not separately)
Best Man should be the last person listed

Lectors: (Do not identify what they're reading, just list their names)

Name of first reader
Name of second reader
Name of person reading petitions

Presider:

The priest/deacon presiding at the ceremony

Musicians:

List them by name, alphabetically
This category is not essential
